FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Over the last few weeks we have been having discussions about our class structure for next year. We have decided that once again we will operate with seven classes in the main stream. Next year we will also continue to have four classes in the Disability unit and a special class which will be for years 2-6. It is essential for future planning that we have accurate student numbers when forming classes for next year. Please let us know if you will definitely not be here next year or if you know of new families who are looking to enrol at our school as we most certainly have some vacancies.

Even though we are nearing the end of the school year, it is critical that each child attend school each day. Just a reminder that if your child is going to be away or late please phone the school. It is important that wherever possible you sign your child in at the front office if they are late. We cannot enter a reason given by a minor this also applies to sibling absences. It is also important that if you need to pick up your child early for any reason then you must first sign them out at the front office. We appreciate your understanding in this matter as it is important to have correct records for the safety of our students and reassurance for parents to know the school monitors this .

It is hard to comprehend that almost 52 years ago around this time in 1970 that the Southern block was opened for the first time to cater for the increased numbers of students attending our school.

A reminder that the end of year concert this year will take place on Tuesday 13th December from 6:00 pm. Parents and caregivers are more than welcome to arrive anytime from 5:00pm. There will be more information about the structure of the end of year concert over the next two weeks. As has been the case for all whole school events over the last few years it will be subject to change if directed to do so as a result of a change in health recommendations.
