FROM THE PRINCIPAL

I would just like to remind parents that we have been participating in Jump Rope for Heart this term. Jump Rope for Heart is a fantastic physical activity and fundraising program that has been run by the Heart Foundation for nearly 40 years. It's a great way for children to keep fit and learn new skills, but it also helps raise funds for vital heart research and education programs. Our school has a strong history in participating in Jump Rope for Heart and in fact 20 years ago we had our own Jump rope team called the Ingle E Stars. We will hold our school Jump Off Day next week.

Continuing with a healthy theme, earlier this year we had the Dental for Schools van visit our school. It was great to see that so many families took up the opportunity to book children in for a visit. After the visit we were provided data which indicated that 37% of our students who had a visit had some form of decay. There are many factors which contribute to tooth decay inclusive of diet, oral hygiene (brushing and flossing teeth) and fluoride exposure (use of tooth-paste). For more information about Dental for Schools and dental hygiene, please check out their website.

I would like to remind parents/ caregivers that all Department for Education schools are smoke free zones. The Department recognises active and passive smoking is a health risk. All persons in a Department workplace or involved in a Department activity should be protected from the involuntary inhalation of tobacco smoke.

The Department for Education has a Smoke free policy which aims to protect the health of Department workers and others (including students) by prohibiting smoking and providing a clear message to the community that Department is committed to reducing harm caused by tobacco smoking. Smoking is prohibited at all Department for Education workplaces and is not permitted within ten metres of children's playground or perimeter of a Department site.

A reminder that later on this term parents/caregivers will have the opportunity to discuss their child's progress, as part of our term three interviews.

Finally, today is RUOK? Day. RUOK? Day is a day dedicated to reminding everyone to ask, "Are you OK?" and to start a meaningful conversation whenever you spot the signs that someone that you care about might be struggling with life. On this day I also ask you to check out how you are travelling. If you feel that you are not OK then please do something about it.

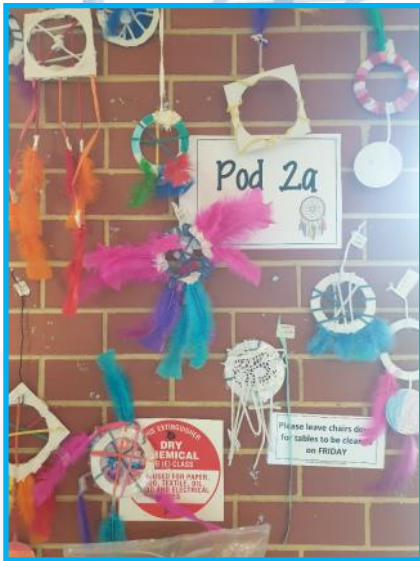
