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FROM THE PRINCIPAL

To begin this edition of the newsletter, I would like to publically acknowledge our students who have been part of the Children's University initiative this year. It was a great privilege as principal of Ingle Farm East primary school to be part of the graduation ceremony on Monday. This year, 5 students graduated with 1 student awarded the Silver certificate for 165 hours, 2 students awarded Bronze certificates for 130 hours and 2 students received Bronze awards for 30 hours. I would like to thank Matt Kerslake for his role in organising Children's University and also for supporting on the night even though he is currently acting principal at North Ingle primary school. I would also like to thank the families who have supported Children's University this year and those that were able to attend the graduation ceremony at Bonython hall.

This week our reception – year 5 students have been participating in swimming lessons at the Elizabeth Aquadome. The Department for Education swimming program provides a fantastic opportunity for students to develop a range of knowledge, skills, understanding and attitudes about:

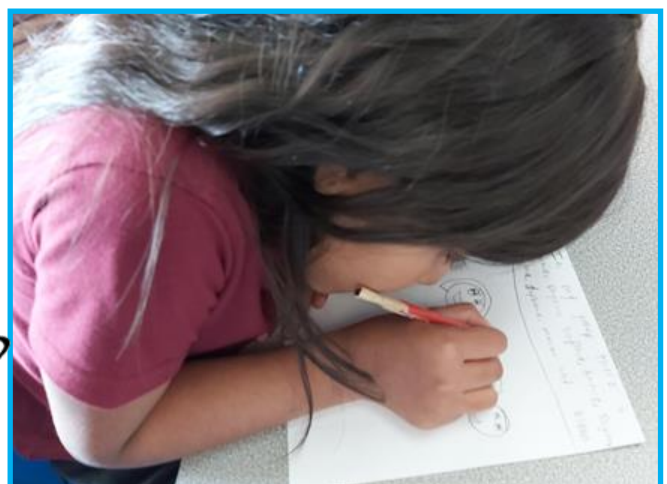
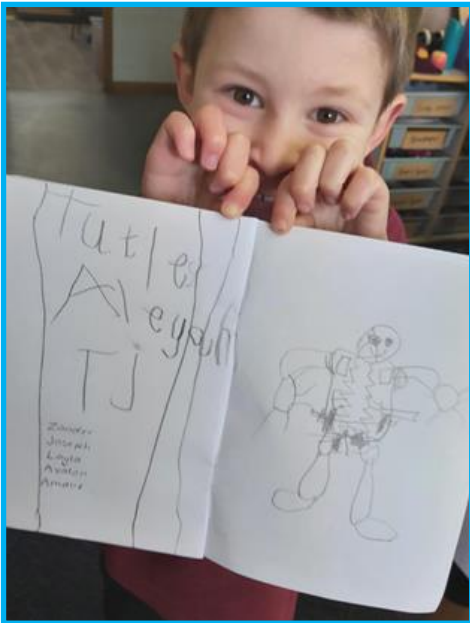

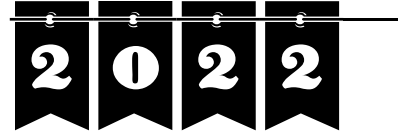
